# CRICKLEWOOD WANDERERS FC

Middlesex County Football League Premier Division

BOTH CRICKLEWOOD WANDERERS AND CLAPTON CFC LOST their opening day fixtures last weekend, so today presents a chance for both to get back on track.

In a clash of the top two, as it stood before last season was abruptly ended, Cricklewood lost a nine-goal thriller at home to Brentham.

Meanwhile CCFC slumped to a surprise 1-0 defeat at home to Indian Gymkhana, for our first defeat at the Wadham Lodge Stadium.

The Tons hit both the post and the bar but in truth looked rusty, perhaps due to it being 196 days since their last competitive game.

That last game was coincidentally home to Cricklewood, a 1-1 behind closed doors game in March.

Wanderers have a short, but inspirational history. The club was formed in 2011 by a group of young people with help from homeless charity Ashford Place.

It is now run by Youth Engagement Solutions (YES), a charity which helps young people in education, employment, training, sport and health. Unlike many grassroots teams, players don't pay subs to play as they strongly believe in making football accessible.

They sponsor dedicated candidates through their coaching badges, providing finance, work experience and for many, a paid coaching role upon completion.

On the pitch, the men's won promotion to the Middlesex County League Premier in their second season.

Since then they've had some near misses from promotion with a second-placed finish in 2013/4 then third in 2017/8.

In 2018/9 they finished bottom, winning just three games, but were reprieved from relegation.

Then they impressively bounced back last season, including a 5-0 victory over the Tons.

Geoff Ocran's team want revenge for that as well as to bounce back from last week's disappointment.

## **NEW SIGNINGS**

Five new names have been added to the CCFC men's first team squad this summer.

Midfielder Nick Muir and defender Tafari Nicholas made their debuts in the defeat last week against Indian Gymkhana, while young winger Reece Bartholomew came off the bench.

Attackers <u>Dan Florence</u> and <u>Nathan Linton</u> are also newly registered, while we await international clearance for another midfielder.
