NEW COACH JOINS

Player/manager Geoff Ocran has appointed Ridhwaan Yusuf as first team coach. Coach Ruudy has 17 years' coaching experience, including first team coach for both Billericay Town's men's and women's teams, and most recently manager of Harlow Town Ladies. He is also the founder and head coach of R77 Academy for youngsters aged between 4 and 15 in East London. Ruudy joins Sham Darr, Jack Mellors and Matt Bailey on the coaching team assisting Geoff.

CUP CHANGE

In the last programme we said the men's first team would be in three cups this season. The Eastern Counties League have said that is too ambitious alongside 40 league games and so we're now down to two cups - the BBC Essex Premier Cup and the league cup.

SAMBA MOVES ON

Young midfielder Samba Badjana has joined Highland League side Forres Mechanics after impressing in a trial. He left CCFC last season to join National League team Chelmsford City, where he made five first team appearances plus 24 for the reserves, including six goals.



PHYSIO NEEDED

Our men's first team are seeking a paid physio. Applicants will need to be available for all home and away games, need to have passed "The FA Intermediate Treatment of Injury" course or equivalent, have experience as a physio for a football team, and hold a valid first aid certificate. ADMISSION CHARGES

FA and league rules state we must charge a minimum £4 for competitive games at this level. This means we have to slightly adjust our admission prices:

Admission: £4

Concessions: Pay what you want Under 13s: Free

Concessions include: Clapton CFC members; Newham residents; Teenagers (13 to 19); Over 60s; Students and apprentices; Trade union members; Unemployed people and those on low income; People with disabilities and health conditions; Refugees, asylum seekers and undocumented migrants – No ID is required to qualify for concessions, we will take your word for it.

If you do not fit any of the

above concession categories, we must charge you £4 by FA rules. There is no minimum price set for the division that our women's first team play in. However, we want to maintain equity with the men's first team, particularly since the women's first team are our highest placed team in the sixth tier of the pyramid. So we will now be suggesting a £4 donation for women's first team games too, with the same list of concessions.

TRAINING PITCH NEEDED

The men's first team have an issue with their new training pitch at Barking Riverside School, which was booked for a full pitch for the season. The headteacher has now banned all external hires after another team using the facility accessed part of the site they shouldn't.

Of course, we have already had a small taste of what is to come. The final two home fixtures of the 2022/23 season were played here, seeing 3-0 and 5-1 victories as the Middlesex County Football League Premier Division title was sealed, with bumper crowds and celebratory atmospheres.

After beginning the new season with two consecutive away games, our first visitors of the new season are St. Margaretsbury FC. The club from St Margarets in Hertfordshire was founded in 1894 as

Stanstead Abbotts FC, before renaming as St. Margaretsbury in 1962.

A Chartered Standard Senior & Youth Football Club in Hertfordshire, in addition to their men's first team, they have an Under 18 Academy team, youth football between 7 and 18 years, and a women's team. Through their long history, they have played variously across the Hertfordshire, South Midlands and Essex regions, last featuring in the Essex Senior League in the 2021-22 season.
