Good afternoon and welcome to the Maurice Rebak Stadium for today's match. We welcome the players, officials and supporters of Clapton Community, hope that they enjoy their brief stay with us and have a safe trip home. Having had an indifferent start to the season our visitors currently sit proudly at the top of the league table and have lost just one of their last sixteen matches. Playing at the famous Old Spotted Dog ground, the club benefit from a large and enthusiastic following as we experienced back in October when a late Ciaran Jelly cross-cum-shot was all we had to show from our afternoon's work.

Two weeks ago we travelled to Harlow for what we knew would be a difficult match. That being said, we found ourselves two goals ahead after forty minutes thanks to two strikes by Wilberforce Ocran. Our tendancy to concede goals in pairs is also a worrying trend as this changes game situation completely in a blink of an eye. There are some good players in our squad who have shown what they are capable of, but we lack consistency and our current league position is a reflection of that.

Just before Christmas, our manager Malik Yansaneh decided to step down due to increasing work commitments. We would all like to thank Malik for his hard work over the last ten months. I know that everyone would have hoped that this had been rewarded with better results on the pitch, but it was certainly not due to lack of effort on Malik's part. His assistant Andi Hoxha will replace him in the managerial hot seat for the time being. Andi has stood in for Malik on a couple of occasions lately and the team have put in good performances each time. He knows all the players very well and hopefully he will be able to get the very best out of the playing staff.

Today's is the first of three home games in quick succession. Next Saturday we host Southend Manor while three days later Newbury Forest are the visitors. January looks to be a pivotal months in the fortune of Enfield Borough as we face a schedule of seven matches, four of which are away from home.

As this is our last home match of the year, on behalf of everyone at Enfield Borough, I wish you all a very Happy New Year.



Harlow Town 4 Enfield Borough 2

Despite an excellent performance from centre-forward Wilberforce Ocran, Enfield Borough were unable to hold on to a two-goal lead at promotion-chasing Harlow Town on Saturday. Conceding two goals just before the interval deflated the visitors and they were unable to raise their game to the same standard in the second-half.

Borough opened the scoring on eight minutes. Following a long punt downfield from keeper Finn Rushton, Ocran and Harlow's Fabian Simms chased the ball down as James Pellin left his line to hack clear. As the players converged, a fortunate rebound saw the ball land perfectly for Ocran to nod into an empty goal. Junior Dadson replied for the hosts soon after, but his effort was ruled out for offside. Harlow had the majority of the possession, but Borough's defence held strong, never more so than when Luke Bailey took the ball away from Dadson when the forward was clean through on goal. Meanwhile Enfield were dangerous on the counter but Jacob Melford's weak shot was easily dealt with while Samir Sedaoui dragged his shot wide having been set up by good work from Ocran and Kyle Finlayter-Lynch. Five minutes before

the break Ocran received the ball thirty yards from goal. He outmuscled his marker and jinked past another

defender before firing the ball low to Pellin's right.

Had they been able to hold that advantage for any length of time the outcome may have been different but within three minutes Jack Zelinski outfoxed Bailey and shot low under Rushton. Then deep into stoppage time Raheem Gray connected with a cross into the six-yard box to steer the ball home. Enfield had the first chance after the break but Sedaoui's long range effort was parried by Pellin. Ocran, who had tormented

Harlow's defence was substituted around the hour mark and with him went the visitor's main threat.

Midway through the second-half Harlow scored twice in a minute to seal victory. A left wing free-kick was knocked beyond the far post where it was played back into the goalmouth for Fabion Sims to tap home before Ruben Santos was left unmarked and he picked his spot from twenty-five yards to fire beyond the reach of Rushton. Despite a number of substitutions, Enfield were unable mount a significant threat as the minutes ticked by.

Enfield Borough 1 Hoddesdon Town 4

Enfield Borough failed to recover from conceding a goal in the opening sixty seconds when they lost at home to Hoddesdon Town by 4-1 on Saturday. Having collected six points from their previous three matches, any hopes that they could continue their improved recent were quickly dashed.

The deadlock was broken as Hoddesdon's Dion Laughton broke clear and as Finn Rushton tried to close in the striker clipped the ball over the keeper and into the vacant net. The visitors kept up the onslaught and Rushton was forced to tip a dipping shot from Harrison Cage over the bar. Borough's response was tepid as Azad Akgundogdu fired well over having been set up by Marco Magunga and Wilberforce Ocran whilst Jacob Melford's cross-cum-shot was comfortably grasped by Liam Nugent. Just past the half hour Hoddesdon doubled the advantage when a corner lead to a spell of penalty box pinball that ended with Jack Riddle nodding home. It could have been worse for the hosts but Rushton saved well after a mistake by Sam Aggrey-Adams had let in Connor Bolton.

Apart from Borough's triple substitution, there was little of note happening in the opening twenty minutes of the second-half, but when something did it merely heaped more misery on Enfield. Narcin Filip got to the byeline before cutting the ball back to Laughton who scored off the inside of the post. This setback did generate a response and three minutes later after Kyle Finalyter-Lynch had battled valiantly for possession, Ocran was on hand to slam the ball home from six yards. Borough were now dominating territorially, but had precious little to show for their efforts. Their only worthwhile attempts on goal saw Alex Akobimpe's fierce drive from thirty yards bring a sharp reaction save from Nugent whilst Magunga's low shot at the near post was pushed behind for a corner. The final word belonged to Hoddesdon when three minutes into stoppage time Riddle was left unmarked at a corner to place his header beyond Rushton to seal their victory.


