THEY WORE THE SHIRT: ELIOT CROSBIE

ELIOT'S GOAL IN LAST SEASON'S LEGENDS MATCH evoked memories of when he captained the team to a league and cup double in our inaugural season. During that season, Eliot made the most appearances, missing only three games, and was second leading scorer behind Sherwin Stanley. His five goals in the 11-1 rout of Hereford Palace is an individual scoring record for the Men's First Team.

Arguably his most vital goal was the late winner in the 6-5 league win against Curve at The Stray Dog. That goal capped an incredible fightback after we trailed 2-4 at half time, and 4-5 late into the game. Victory in the final two games ensured that the MCFL Central and East title was won by a single point.

During his time at CCFC Eliot scored in thirteen different games of which twelve were won and one lost. Sadly, Eliot wasn't able to repeat the exploits of that first season as work commitments and living in West London curtailed his future contribution to the club.

MEET THE COACHING TEAM

AT THE START OF THE NEW SEASON, IT'S TIME to put the spotlight on the Clapton CFC Men's First Team backroom staff.

The Manager is of course Geoff Ocran, who has been in the hot seat since the club was formed in the summer 2018. It's Geoff's first managerial role, but he's masterminded two promotions and two cups.

Our Assistant Manager is Sham Darr, who joined the coaching team a few months later in 2018 in our debut season. Sham had previously managed and coached at London Apsa, Ilford and Wadham Lodge.

Geoff and Sham are both still registered as players, aged 39 and 38 respectively, so you may see them back on the field in an injury crisis.

Ridhwaan Yusuf, more commonly known as Coach Ruudy, is our Head Coach. Ruudy joined us last season after our promotion to Step 6, having previously been

first team coach for both Billericay Town's men's and women's teams and manager of Harlow Town Ladies., He is also the founder and head coach of R77 Academy.

We have two First Team Coach roles, filled by Jack Mellors and Matt Bailey. Both have been on the coaching team for several seasons through our rise up the leagues.

The Physiotherapist for a second season is Kasita Boateng while Aaqib Hafeji also continues as Data Analyst.

SOUL TOWER HAMLETS WERE KNOWN JUST as Tower Hamlets until this summer, when they merged with Soul FC from the Essex Alliance League.

The club formed as Bethnal Green United FC in 2000 in the Middlesex County Football League and were promoted into the Essex Senior League in 2008. They've won the Gordon Brasted and ESL Cup trophies and reached the last 16 of the FA Vase. Meanwhile, Soul - which stands for Soul Organisation For Unity and Leisure - is a community organisation formed in 2003.
