Denham United formed in 1998 and are the largest all female club in the south east of England. They have an impressive number of teams across a large age range and their own ground, The Den, in Uxbridge. They spent eight seasons in the FA Women's National League Division 1 South, two levels above, before dropping back down to the sixth tier. This season they were laterally moved from our league to the Southern Region Women's Football League.

Form guide

Having finished fifth in our division last season - five points and two places above us - they're in unstoppable form in their new division. They've recorded 6 wins out of 6, scoring 40 goals and conceding just 5.

Previous meetings

We've won all 6 league meetings - though lost our only cup meeting, 5-4 at home in the League Cup two seasons ago. Our 4-1 win in 2022 was our first competitive win at the Old Spotted Dog Ground.

In a team full of goals, Niamh Cashin is leading the way with 12 then Pia Davis 8. Last season's top scorer Jenny Nagle appears to now be dual signed with Chesham United a few divisions higher.
