Welcome to today's visiting players, coaches, supporters and officials

The club was formed in 1906 as St Anne's Kew, changing its name in 1911 to Kew Association FC and then its current name in 2020. The men's team joined the Southern Amateur League in 1925 so are celebrating their centenary. In 1996 they managed to find their own ground at Ham and they now have dozens of youth and adult teams. The women's team was formed in 2021 and enjoyed two promotions in their first three seasons. Last season - their first at this level - they finished sixth, one place above CCFC.

Form guide

Richmond sit in ninth in the table with two wins so far. They beat Soccer Elite Football Academy 13-0, and also put 11 goals past Epsom & Ewell in the FA Cup, so they know where the goal is.

Previous meetings

All have been won by the away side so far. Earlier this season, we won 2-1 with both goals from Emily Link. Last season we won 3-0 away then at the Old Spotted Dog Ground, R&K came back from 2-0 down to win 3-2.
