In 2022/23 they opted to laterally move to the Essex Alliance League, though sadly last season were relegated from the Senior Division to the Premier West.

Performance wise, Saturday's 2-2 draw here against Hutton was a vast improvement from the Cannons Wood game we lost the week before - but then again many would say that wasn't too difficult. It was more of a back to basics sort of game as we expected Hutton to provide a different sort of test.

Our record against our play-off rivals has been good this season to date so if we were offered four points pre-season in our two games against Hutton, we probably would have taken it. However, the disappointing element of the game is conceding straight after half-time and then shortly after the second goal. Two lapses of concentration across the 90 minutes have cost us two points so it's an area of improvement required in a game of fine margins. We've got to try to put a good run of wins together, particularly at home, like we had earlier in the season.

Tonight is the last cup competition we are in so we want to progress as far as possible. However, we do need to rotate and rest some of the squad nursing injuries at the moment. Games against lower opposition in the pyramid comes down to application and mindset so it's on us to not allow any complacency tonight. 'Do the job and into the next round' is the memo with no other result acceptable.
