#### BRENTFORD FC

Welcome to today's visiting players, coaches, supporters and officials

Brentford Women began in 1990 and were promoted to the London & South East Regional Women's Division One North five seasons ago. The side went agonisingly close to promotion several times before finally achieving reaching the L&SERWFL Premier with a near perfect season last year. In the summer, longterm manager Karleigh Osborne moved to a club ambassador role. New boss Carly Williams has arrived from Arsenal, along with lots of new signings, as they chase another promotion.

#### Form guide

Brentford won the first 8 games this season. However, they've drawn one and lost two since then. They beat Sevenoaks Town 7-1 in the previous round of this cup.

#### Previous meetings

Brentford have won 6 of our 8 meetings, including 7-0 last September in front of a 3585 crowd. Our one draw was 2-2 at home late in the previous season, which contributed to Sport London e Benfica pipping The Bees to promotion. Our only win came in 2020/21, 3-1 on a very muddy Stray Dog pitch in Walthamstow.

#### Player/s to watch

Ashley Cheatley has been shortlisted for the FIFA Marta Award for one of her 46(!) goals last season. Football freestyler Chelsie Berry is currently this season's top scorer with 6 goals having progressed from the B team.
