Two successive relegations brought them to the Eastern Counties League Division One South last season, where they just missed out on the playoffs by one point and place.

DOUBTS OVER DUNMOW

There's a question mark over the survival of Dunmow Town, who play in our division. The club recently notified the Eastern Counties League they were folding and all their remaining fixtures were officially cancelled. However, interested parties are now trying to save the club, which has been groundsharing at Hoddesdon Town this season. League bosses

gave Dunmow a deadline of yesterday to either confirm a deal to save the club or to reaffirm withdrawal. If they do end up folding, all their results will be declared null and void as they have not completed 75% of the season. That would mean CCFC losing the three points we gained in August's 5-0 home win, though other teams would drop points too.
