BRIMSDOWN FC

Welcome to today's visiting players, coaches, supporters and officials

The old Brimsdown Rovers - famed for former player David Beckham - merged with Enfield 1893 FC in 2010. Three years later, Brimsdown FC was formed as a successor, playing in the Spartan South Midlands League, as well as an academy and 8 youth teams. Owner Ahmet Toygun hopes to bring Brimsdown FC back to the Enfield area and own their own ground.

Form guide

After losing to CCFC in August, Brimsdown then went on an amazing 17 game unbeaten run. That finally ended in December with 3 defeats leaving them in eighth place, just outside the play-off places.

Previous meetings

We won 3-2 away after being 2-0 down through goals from Sam Cook (2) and Fred Taylor. However, just weeks later Brimsdown knocked us out of the FA Vase on penalties after a 0-0 draw. Our first meeting came in the Eastern Counties League in September 2023 - another 0-0 away draw. The reverse fixture in December 2023 saw us edge it 1-0 with a rare goal from Bailey Pryce.

Player/s to watch

Our own Development Team striker Emmanuel Olasehinde is now captaining Brimsdown aged 19. Matas Machovas is the second top scorer in the division with 20 goals already.

2025 STATS ROUND-UP

Clapton CFC Men's First Team played **48 times** in 2025 - the most they've played in a calendar year. The team recorded their most wins **[29]** and most goals scored **[109]** too. **16 clean sheets** were kept, another record, while they failed to score on four occasions.

The biggest win was **6-1** at home to Halls Athletic and biggest

defeat **1-5** away to Sheppen Sports. A total of **14,585 fans** watched the **30 games** here at the Old Spotted Dog Ground. The average gate of **486** was up by 22 on 2024.

42 different players were used, with **12 making their debuts**. **19 players** won a POTM vote and **23 scored**. 71 yellow cards were awarded and 1 red.


