Founded in 1898, Barkingside FC rose from the Ilford League to become a staple of non-league football, playing variously in the London, Essex, and South Midlands leagues and winning the London Senior Cup and several league titles. A young Jimmy Greave played a few matches for them in the 1950s. They enjoyed a three-year spell at Step 4 from 2013 and have been at Step 6 since 2019.
