WIVENHOE TOWN FC

Welcome to today's visiting players, coaches, supporters and officials

Wivenhoe Town were formed in 1925 and have been based at Broad Lane since 1977 when it was a carrot field. After decades in local leagues, their heyday was the late Eighties and early Nineties when they reached Step 3, the Isthmian League Premier Division. They set their attendance record of 1,992 in the FA Trophy against Runcorn in 1990 while the next season they played neighbours Colchester in the same competition in front of 4,923 at Layer Road.

Form guide

The Dragons were reprieved from relegation last season but have started this term with three wins out of four. New manager Craig Gillam has led the revival, having performed a great escape from relegation with Dunmow Town at the end of last season, and has brought many of those players with him.

Previous meetings

This will be our second meeting with the Dragons, having visited Broad Lane for our FA Vase debut in 2019, losing 5-1 with our goal scored by makeshift striker Nick Loblack. At the time we were a division below but now find ourselves a division above Wivenhoe.

Player/s to watch

Striker Harry Miller has 6 goals in 5 games already this season.

MEN'S TEAM FRIENDLY RECORD

The friendly against New York International exactly a month ago today saw the **Men's First Team's** best ever friendly crowd of 781. It also narrowly beat the 775 who attended the **Women's First Team** friendly against St Pauli on June 20, 2023. The best pre-season crowd of 1153 was **FC United of Manchester's** double header visit on July 15, 2023 but the FSA Trophy was at stake so we class it as competitive.

Overall, the Men's First Team have played **71 friendlies** against **50 different teams** with four games against **NW London** the most common opposition. Six friendlies have been against international teams: this summer at home to **New York International** and away to **UC Ceares**; previous trips to **CE Jupiter**,

CD Independiente de Vallecas and **Rotern Stern Leipzig**; and home to **UE Sant Miquel**.

The first ever friendly was July 21, 2018, with a 5-0 loss on a trip to **Holland FC** in Clacton. The **first win was 4-2** against **Sporting Hackney** a few weeks later on August 4, with Eliot Crosbie scoring CCFC's first ever goal. The first home friendly on August 25 was a **5-2 win** against **Wanderers**, with Crosbie scoring CCFC's first goal at home. A photo of our away shirt went viral afterwards and sparked an unexpected stampede for replica shirts.

The biggest friendly win was July 31, 2021, **9-2** at home against Cuffley, with Noah Adejokun scoring a record four goals. Our biggest defeat was July 13 this summer, 0-9 at Hashtag United.

David Makisi produced one of the few moments of quality all game to put the ball on Fred Taylor's head for the equaliser taking us to penalties.

A special mention to all five penalty takers especially Nico Bunduku on the final crucial penalty for holding his nerve to win the shootout. As a young player, it's a moment to never forget and should boost his confidence.

Credit also to all the subs who came on and played their part including two debuts in defence for Daniel Adjei and Tiere Beaupierre which shows where we are in that department.

Our injury list just keeps growing and growing and that really dictates squad selection each game. It's difficult to settle the squad at the moment.

However, the first half was probably our worst half of the season so far and we had to let the players know at half-time that it was not acceptable collectively and individually, particularly when so many people have come to watch.

BBC Essex Senior Cup time again tonight and another home draw vs Wivenhoe Town. It's always difficult to know what side the opposition will field as it tends to be low down on the agenda for many teams and it's a very long away trip on a Tuesday night.

We will rotate as we need to keep players fresh and sharp for the busy month ahead but we do want to progress to the next round as it's something we haven't achieved before. So it's Essex Senior Cup tonight, Men's FA Cup on Saturday and then a very important league game the following Saturday.
