Actonians LFC was founded in 1998 as Chiswick United, before becoming Acton Sports Club four seasons later and then in 2008 part of historic men's club Old Actonians. Last year, the club made the name change from Actonians Ladies to Women. The women's first team, which is in the fourth tier, was bought by former USA international Stephanie McCaffrey, who is also playing up front. However, the rest of the Actonians club including the Reserves remains separate.

Actonians Reserves started the season with a 3-0 defeat at home to Maidstone United, having finished last season in a very impressive fourth place.

Previous meetings

Over the years it's been three wins, four losses and one draw. Actonians did the double over us in the league last season - a 3-1 defeat away was followed by a 4-1 loss at home. In between we gained a small amount of revenge with a 3-0 away win in the cup.

Player/s to watch

Katy Hanscomb was the second top scorer in the division last season with 25 goals with Holly Reid not far behind on 16, with both scoring twice against us.

Florence "Flo" Hobbes, Centre Back

Flo is a centre back who spent six years in the West Midlands, playing for Knowle Women FC, where she won the league, as well as Solihull Sporting and University of Birmingham. Before Birmingham she played for MK Dons and Chesham United. She's now back home in the south. She supports QPR, but you're more likely to find her at the Emirates with a pint, watching Arsenal Women.

Ellie Dunn, Full-Back

Ellie is able to play either left back or right back. She played most recently for University of Nottingham and Liverpool Feds reserves. She supports Liverpool, with Steven Gerrard and Ronaldinho as her favourite players. By her own admission, she's not even the best player in her family: her sister played for England and won the FA Cup.

Genevieve Buabeng, Striker / Winger

Genevieve is a striker/winger who previously played for South Park as well as Governors State University in Illinois in the United States. Away from football, she's into sim racing, gardening, and looking after her cats.

Noora Oikarainen and Verity "Vee" Hayward have been promoted to the First Team squad from the Reserves.

Vee played primarily as an attacking number 10 in the reserves, but is making a name for herself on the wing so far this season.
